RULE 105 BREWING RELEASES PALE RIDER ALE

GREELEY, COLORADO, Feb 27, 2024 — Rule 105 Brewing in Greeley announces the release of a new collaboration: *Pale Rider Ale*. This pale ale craft beer was designed and brewed to be smooth, highly drinkable, and full bodied. "The beer gets its delicious flavor from the heavy use of Colorado-grown Cascade hops," remarked co-owner and head brewer Michael Mosher. The beer is currently available in draft at the taproom, and in to-go Crowlers (32oz) and growlers (64oz). Rule 105 plans to also have it available in 4-packs of 16oz cans by the middle of March.

Pale Rider Ale is another in the series of Rule 105 Brewing collaborations between Mosher and former brewery owner Randy Waddle. The first was MR IPA, a west-



coast style IPA that is both malty and hoppy. It is now a regular offering on tap at Rule 105. SMASH Juice, an external collaboration with Eddyline Brewing in Buena Vista, was a strawberry-ginger blonde ale. Vicious Greality was a pear-flavored Belgian blonde made with Vicious Cycle Brewing in Fraser. "Collaborating with other brewers," stated Mosher, "helps us learn new techniques, explore new flavors, and stay on top of the current trends in brewing."

Rule 105 Brewing is a woman-owned small business at 4731 W 10th St in Greeley that employs seven beer-tenders and kitchen staff. Rule 105 is known for their warm welcoming environment, live music, and great-tasting ales and lagers. With both an indoor and an outdoor stage, they host bands and solo artists from across the Front Range on a regular basis. They are also the place to watch sporting events, play in cribbage tournaments, and meet friends and colleagues. Rule 105 also has a kitchen that makes pizzas, calzones, pretzel balls, and other items from scratch in their Woodstone Pizza oven. More information can be found at http://rule105brewing.com.
